CHEVROLET COBALT SS COUPE OPEN AIR

What if you took the Chevy Cobalt Coupe and gave it the open-air feeling of a convertible, while maintaining the coupe's roof structure? GM Performance Division engineers asked that question, and the Cobalt SS Coupe Open Air is the answer. It features a Webasto five-panel, electronically operated glass roof that opens up to reveal an interior with unique fabrics, leather-wrapped instrument panel upper, door trim uppers and steering wheel, as well as body-colored bezels and instrument panel trim.

The exterior also receives star treatment, including a special Gold Rush two-stage exterior paint developed specifically for GM Color Studios. Other Cobalt SS Coupe Open Air exterior elements include GMSP0 18-inch, polished aluminum wheels, carbon fiber front and rear fascia extensions, and other body parts. A detailed engine compartment, Wilwood brake rotors and caliper and a GMSP0 catback exhaust system with bright outlets complete the Cobalt SS Coupe Open Air picture.
